Bowlers can only compete in one additional division . <i>The division must be specified during registration. Once the registration has been confirmed, the division cannot be changed</i> • Doubles - Both bowlers have to play in the same squad

3rd game Turbo . The 3rd game, including bonus, within any five-game series.

3rd game Turbo fee - 10 euros. You can register for the ***Turbo game*** before the start of each squad. In the event of a tie, the player above in the general table will qualify. The highest turbo game will advance to the **Step II** of the general standings.

Early bird 1 - Best non-advancer from Thursday squads (SQ1-3) with the highest 5 game total will advance to Final Step 1

Early bird 2 - Best non-advancer from Friday squads (SQ4-8) with the highest 5 game total will advance to Final Step 1

Doubles. The best 10 game total score (including handicap) from all qualification squads. Both bowlers have to play in the same squad. It is possible for one bowler to make more than one doubles pair in one squad. **Doubles fee - 20 euros.**

Step I - qualification

Entries and Reentries - 5 games. In qualifying, the whole game is played on one lane.. After the game, players move one lane to the right.

After final squad of qualifying 18 players in main division will advance to next steps in this order:

Crossline system

Playoffs

Two games will be played from scratch. Two best participants of each division advance to the final game.

Final

One game will be played from scratch. The winner of the game becomes the winner of the division.

STEP II

12 players will compete for 6 spots to advance to STEP III:

Q7-Q15 spots from qualification

Turbo

4 games, crossline, 6 best scores advance to **step III**

STEP III

12 players will compete for 4 spots to advance to semifinals:

Q1-Q6 spots from qualification

6 best scores from ***STEP II***

4 games, crossline 4 best scores advance to semifinals.

SEMIFINALS

Semifinal pairs will be made based on results from **STEP III:**

1st - 4th

2nd - 3rd

1 game will be played crossline system. Winners advance to the grand final.

FINAL

One game will determine the winner of Pajūrio taurė 2026.

Additional information

- Lanes will be dressed before each qualifying squad, women, seniors and amateur finals, before the STEP II, STEP III and Semifinals .
- In the event of a tie, a higher place in the qualification will be awarded according to the higher last game score, including **HCP** .
- In the event of a tie in the final rounds, players will throw one shot until a tie will be broken.
- The organizers reserve the right to change the schedule, regulations and prize pool of the competition.

Practice time

1. Before each qualification squad - **8 minutes.** ;
2. before the final stage of additional divisions - **8 minutes;**
3. before the STEPS II and III - **8 minutes;**
4. before Semifinal and Final - **5 minutes .;**

General rules and procedures

1. Changing the surface of the ball in between games is forbidden.
2. The tournament will follow 78D hardness rule for urethane bowling balls. All other reactive and urethane-like (example: Storm Concept, Hammer NU2.0) bowling balls are allowed if they are on the USBC approved ball list.
